All our servers are located in Finland, Sweden or the EU, which means that our operations comply with GDPR regulations.






Loiston's greatest opportunity to influence is through our core activities within the following UN Sustainability Development goals:

Loiston works as a sponsor for a 9-year-old girl in Cambodia. Loiston supports her monthly. During the last year, we have been able to help ensure that she has access to good nutrition both at home and at school. In addition, she has received school books and hygiene training he needs. Loiston wants to help break the cycle of community poverty and enable a better future. On average, supporting one foster child improves the lives of four other people living in the same community.

In December 2023, we participated in the Christmas Tree collection by donating gifts to children of needy families. Christmas tree collections have been organized in Finland since 2000. The Christmas tree activity is a non-profit charity to support disadvantaged children and young people. Joulupuu ry is the organizer of the most comprehensive Christmas gift collection.
